

PAPER ENGINEERING

CASTLE CONSTRUCTION

60-90 minutes approximately for ages 6 & older

- ❑ Draw on paper your desired castle shape - focus on the front view of it
- ❑ Select various-sized recycle packaging/box/etc to make into castle
- ❑ Complete dry fit of your desired castle shape
- ❑ Reference your first drawing - add additional details as a template for your design
- ❑ Label parts with matching letters or number (A on this plastic bottle & A on tissue box)
- ❑ Use tape or glue to attach together - share various techniques or attaching together
- ❑ Add other details like paper scraps, bits of other materials such as buttons or fabric to create texture, or figurines.

PAPER WEAVING

30-60 minutes approximately for ages 8 & older

- ❑ Collect various paper materials (magazines, maps, construction paper).
- ❑ Use ruler to draw measured out 1 inch lines & cut OR do semi-rough cuts (OR precut materials)
- ❑ Start with 4 strips and complete interlocking/overlapping pattern in center of design
- ❑ Slowly add more paper strips into the weave paper
- ❑ Glue or tape the edges to secure it for framing or lamination for placemats

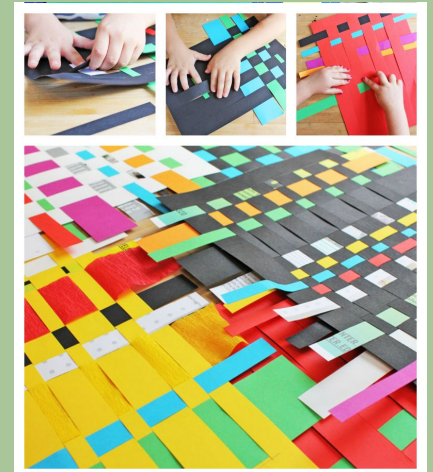
